**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS**

- The College login will be closed after the last date.
- Principals are requested not to forward/submit the EAF of Not Eligible Candidates. The results of Not Eligible candidates will be cancelled at any stage, if they write the examination.

**NOTE:-**

1. The Principal is requested to send the **Faculty list** without which the examination forms will not be accepted.
2. The Principal is requested to verify the eligibility of the students thoroughly and forward the same to this office for the issue of Hall Ticket. If failed to verify the eligibility of the candidates, the principal is held responsible for the issue of hall ticket by this office to the non-eligible candidates.
3. The Principal may kindly forward all the examination application forms **online through College login.**

4. As a part of the Core Banking System, all the students are hereby instructed to deposit the Examination Fee into their respective college accounts only for onward transmission to the University by the college.
5. Not to collect the Exam fee from Blind, Physically Disabled, Deaf & Dumb students as per O.U. Order No. 1555/228/2007-08/Budget-V, dated: 25-03-2008. A Xerox copy of medical Certificate confirming their status as Handicapped (minimum percentage of disability must be of 40% attached to the application forms. Blind, Physically Disabled, Deaf & Dumb student's applications forms should be submitted separately along with separate Nominal Roll.
6. **Any discrepancies with regards to the Candidate data such as Internal marks, Practical, Viva-voce and Projects etc. should be brought to the notice of concerned officials of Examination Branch and obtain the acknowledgement within one month of declaration of results. After one month, queries will not be entertained.**
